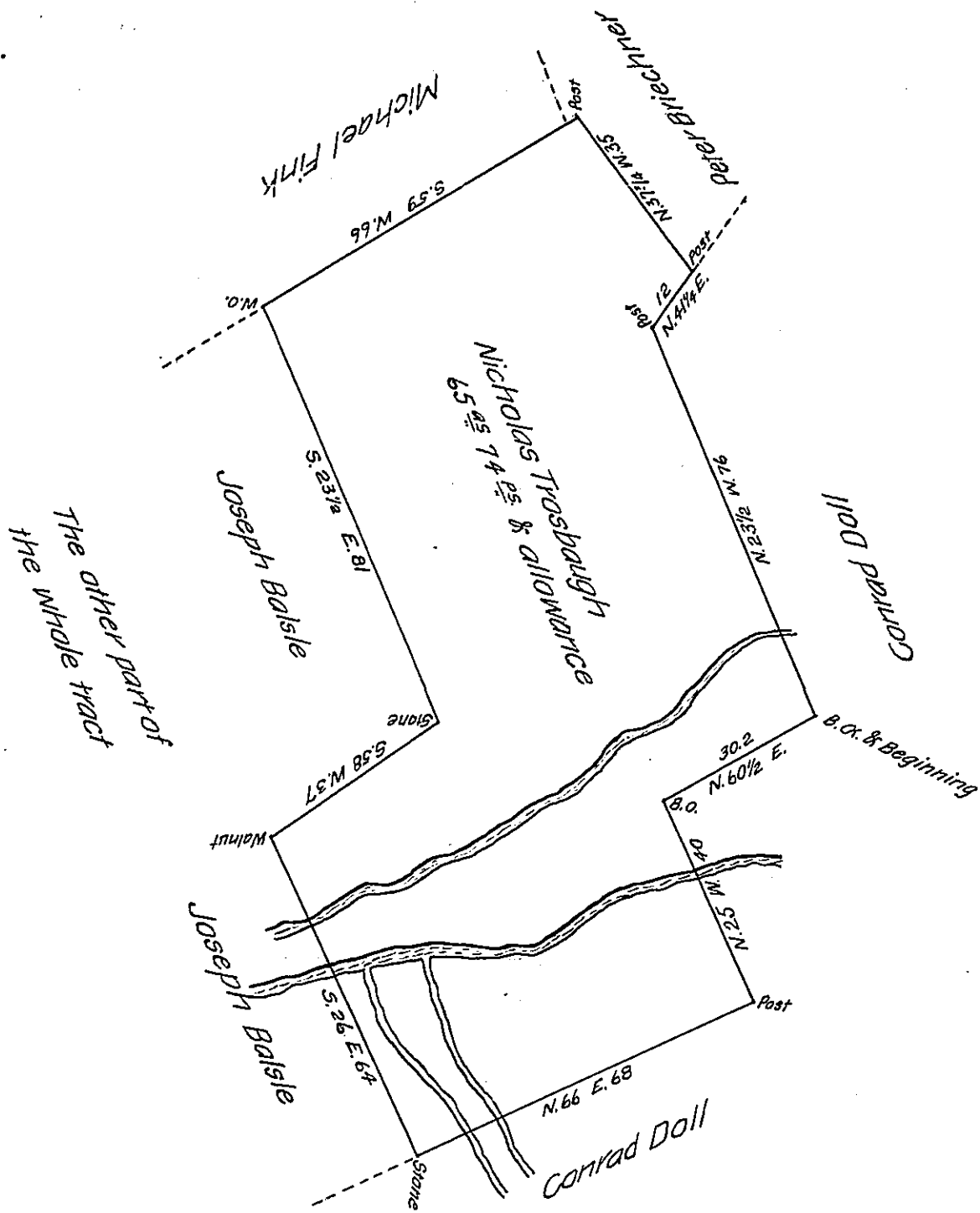


FORM NO 1.



Situate in Paradise Township, York County, and containing as above set forth 65 ²/₃ 74 ²/₃ & allowance. Being a part of a larger tract of 134 ²/₃ 134 ²/₃ and allowance of land which was originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D. S., on the 27th of November 1751, in pursuance of a warrant bearing date the 10th of September 1750 granted to Nicholas Trosbaugh for — acres. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract by William Kersey late D. S., on the 3rd day of the 4th mo. 1783. And now, after having been carefully examined corrected and calculated, it is at the request of the present owner Conrad Doll returned for Confirmation the 28th day of May A.D. 1811.
