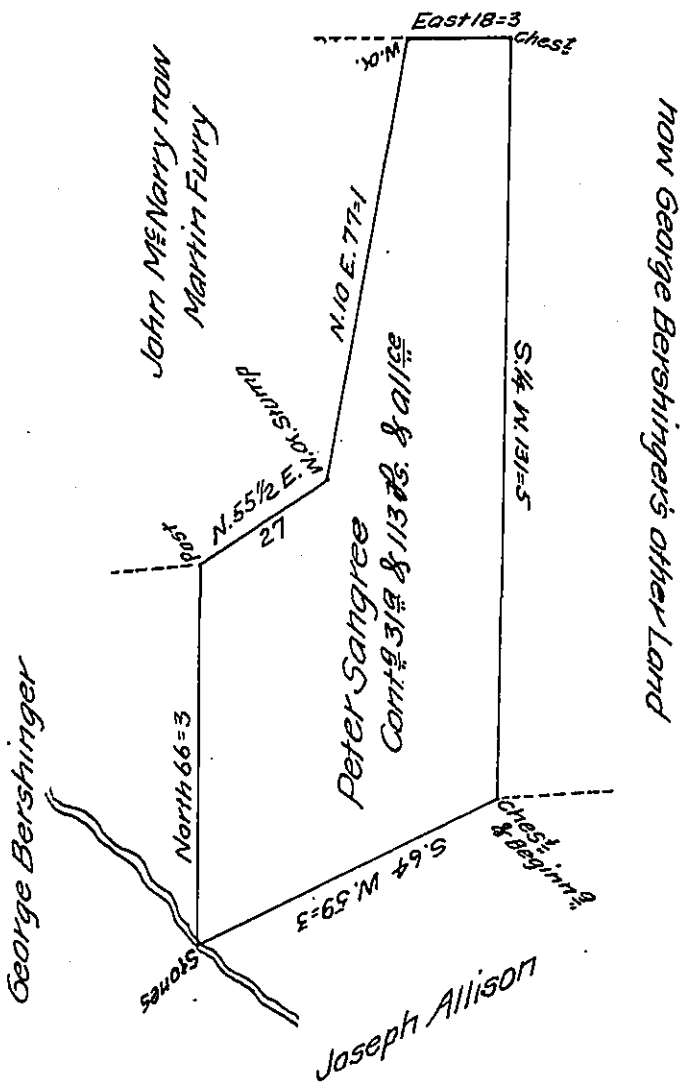


Formerly John Hamilton



Situate in Chanceford Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 31<sup>sq</sup> & 113 <sup>ac</sup> and allowance, &c. Surveyed by John Forsyth late D. S. on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of November A. D. 1799. In pursuance of a Warrant for 60<sup>ac</sup> (directed to be Surveyed in two Pieces) bearing date the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April 1787. Resurveyed by the old lines on the 19<sup>th</sup> of June A. D. 1810, at the request of the owner George Bershinger, who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation.
