



By virtue of a Warrant dated November 30th 1792. Surveyed to Sylvanus Backus November 29th 1867. Containing Seventy Acres and forty six perches and Six per cent allowance for roads &c. adjoining lands of Moses Cleveland. and Situated in Laporte Township, Sullivan County. The dotted lines represent the full warrant but the 70 Acres and 46 perches is all the land I find adjoining Moses Cleveland unappropriated.
