



Situate on the dividing Ridge between the Waters of Stony Creek and Quemahoning- in Quemahoning Township Bedford County & Surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July 1790. In Consequence of a Warrant dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February 1787. Which Warrant proved ineffectual, being located on the south side of Youghiogeni River including the large Glades where George Wells formerly lived in Laurel Hill in Wharton Township Fayette County; the said Land having been Surveyed unto Jn<sup>o</sup> Harrold pursuant to a Warrant for the same. dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January 1787.
