

By virtue of a warrant dated the fifteenth day of October 1800 surveyed  
 the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1801 for Barbara Sprangler the above described tract of  
 land situate in Lower Paxton Township Dauphin County containing Eleven acres and  
 137 Perches and allowance for Roads &c.

N.B. the above tract of land is comprehended in a survey made by Bartram Gal-  
 braith D.S. the second day of August 1765 and returned into the Surveyor  
 Generals Office for Robert Potts on a warrant dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1774  
 for which a Patent was granted unto the said Robert Potts dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day  
 of June 1768 and now claimed title by Leonard Wallour
