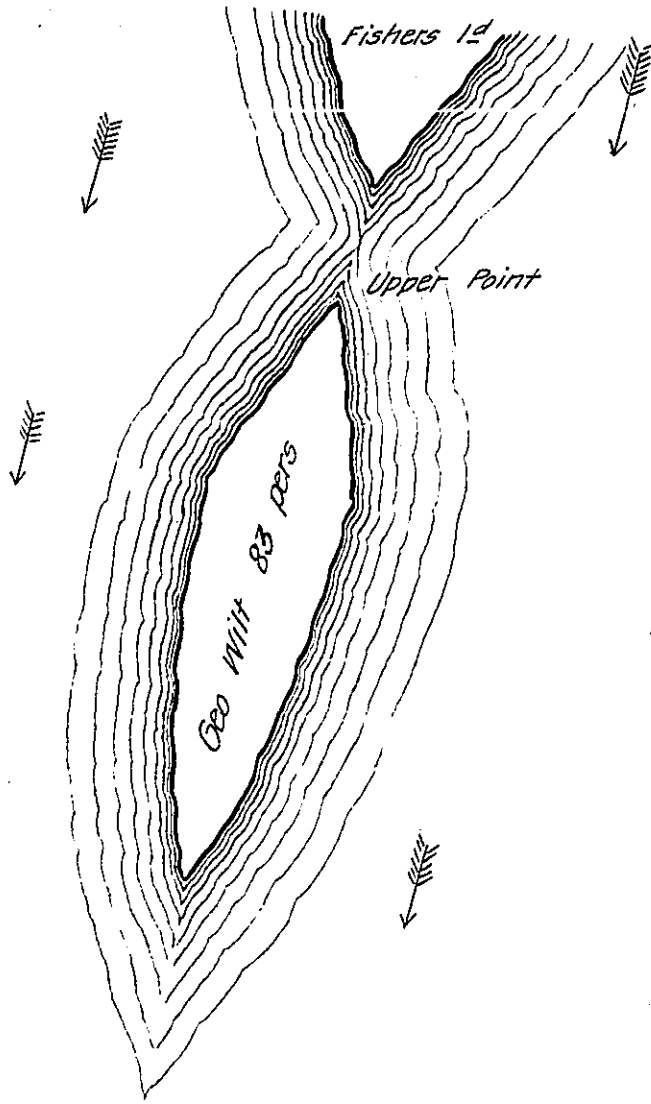

"Birch Island" about four Rods below Fishers Island on the East side of said-Wilts
large Island, and nearly opposite the mouth of Mahantango-Containing Eighty three
perches strict measure by his Warrant dated the 22^d May 1815
