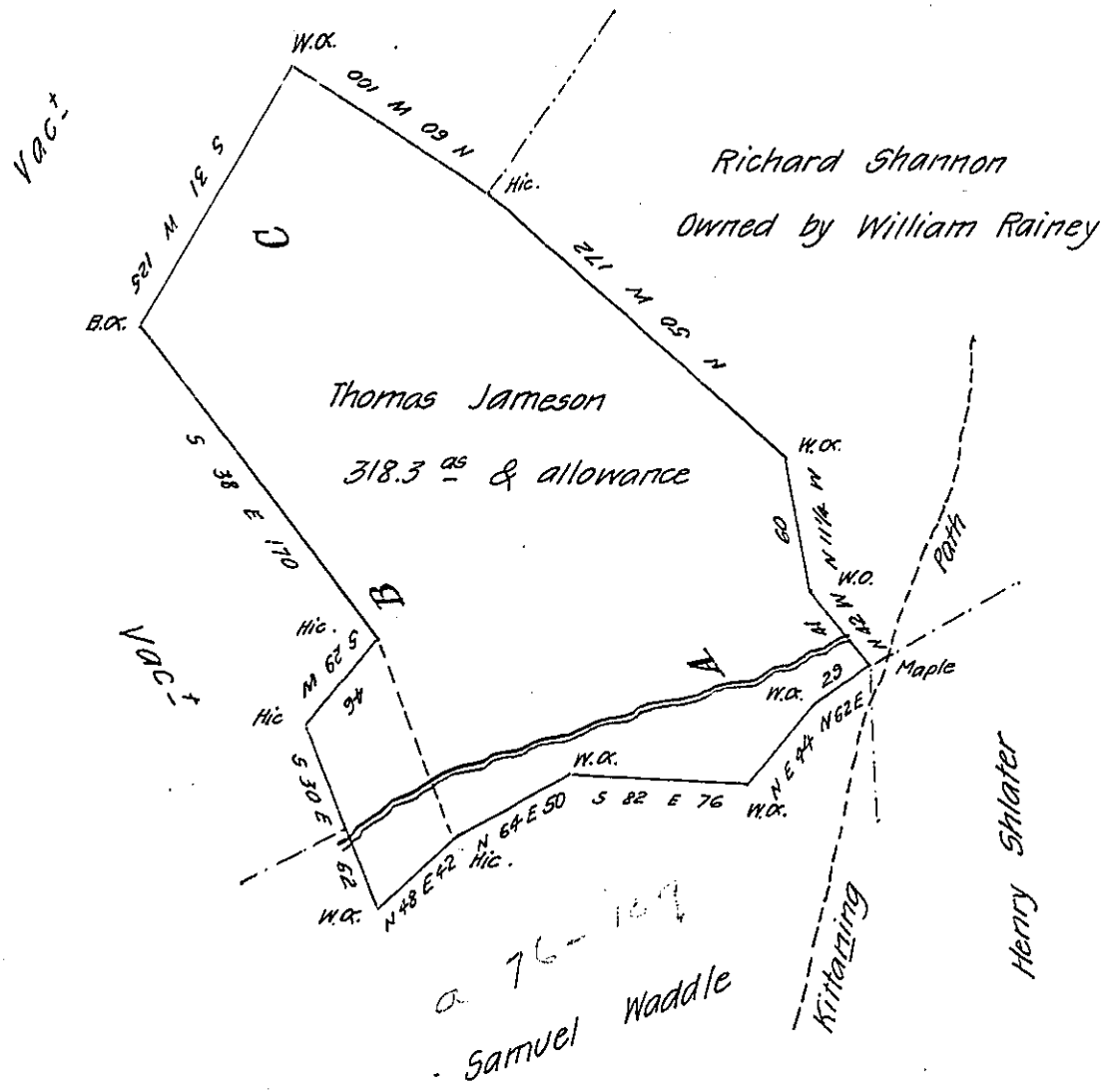


FORM NO 1.



The dotted lines and the letters A.B.C. represent the Survey made to James Simpson on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of February 1828 a return whereof is herewith enclosed. It will be seen by the above diagram that the location of Simpson has been laid upon the ground described. It calls for land on the West side of William Rainey-it <sup>has</sup> been so laid. John McCready ~~owns~~ resides upon this tract and claims under the title to Thomas Jamison which is patented.
