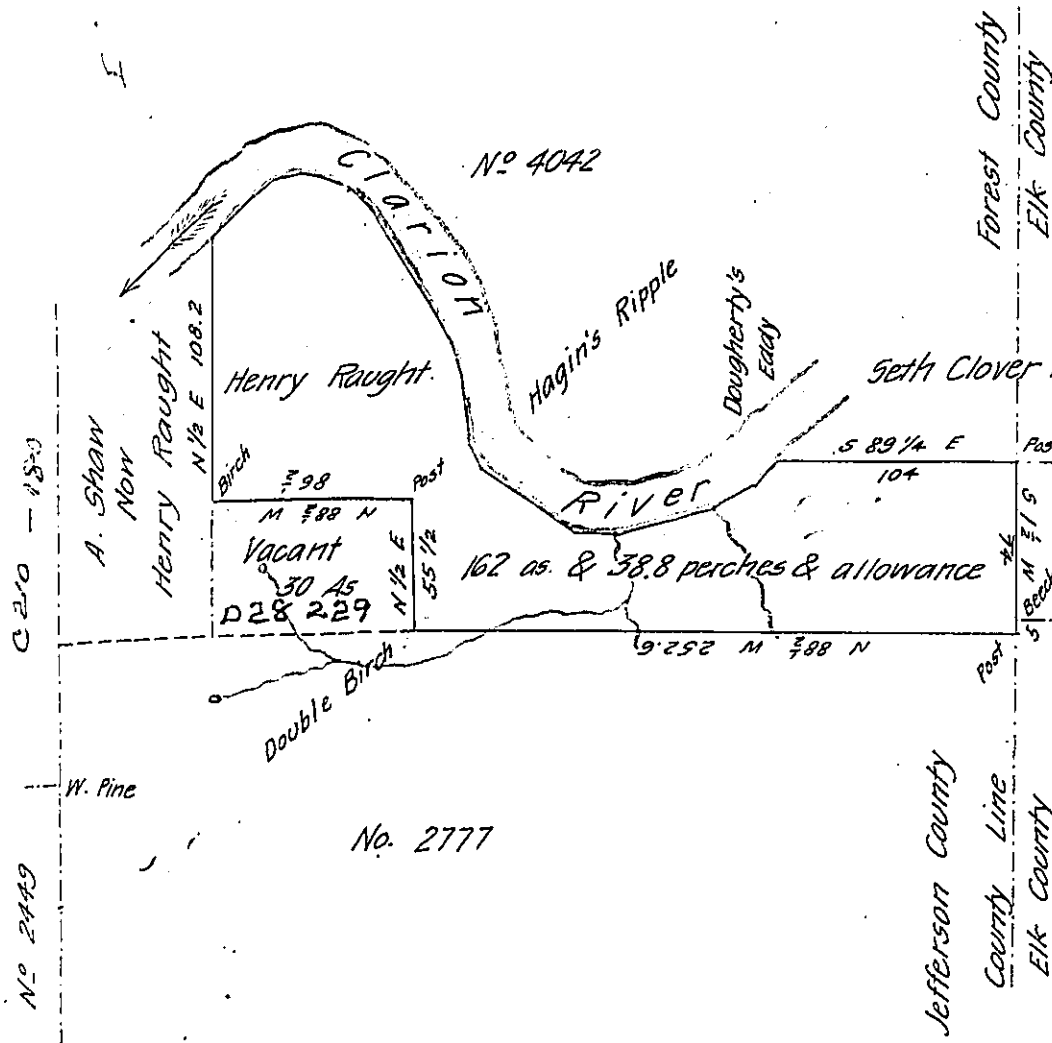

Situate on the South side of Clarion River in the last purchase made of the Indians East of the Alleghany River and Conewango Creek in the Township of Heath and County of Jefferson And returned upon Warrant to Henry Raught dated the 22nd day of June A.D. 1855 and directed to Joel Spyker Esqr.
