After the above Survey was made I ascertained that a survey had been previously made to James Jack on the above land on the 8<sup>th</sup> of October 1824 By warrant of the 28 May 1824 which survey is represented on the above diagram by the dotted lines and letters A. & B. = Jacks. Warrant calls for improved land some distance from the above which is unimproved - The draft in my possession does not represent the adjoining accurately and the warrant being for other land is what has given rise to this mistake
