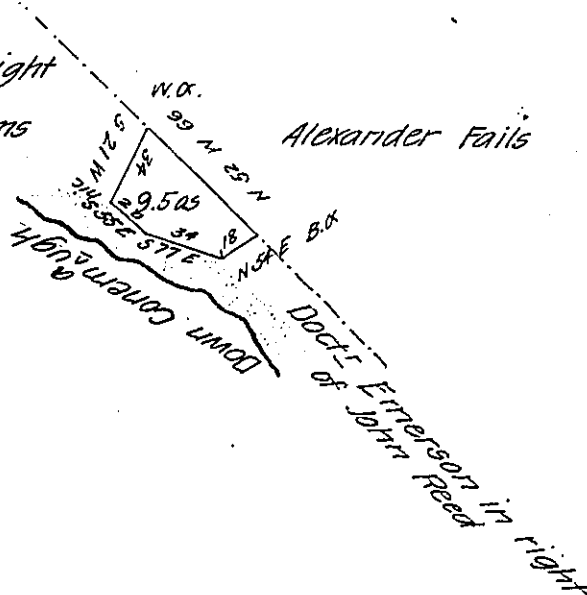


Joseph Barris in right
