



The above is a tract of Land Situate in Sandy Creek Township Mercer County, on Big Sandy Creek, Containing fifty-nine acres and one hundred and forty-nine perches with the allowance of six per cent. for roads &c. Surveyed for Robert Curry the 5th day of May 1826 in pursuance of his actual settlement and improvement, commenced at an early period. On the tract there is a Cabben House and Barn an orchard and a considerable clearing both upland and meadow.

I hereby officially certify that from the Book and other documents, in my office, it does not appear that this land has been appropriated to any person by warrant or otherwise; other than the present applicant.
