



Surveyed the above plot of ground in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Baird dated Feby 29th A.D. 1856. Situate in the township of Shenango, Mercer County called the "Narrow Vacancy" on which William Baird erected a log cabin and resided in it, said cabin being taken down a plank or frame dwelling built and a family living in it. Surveyed for William Baird March 24th A.D. 1856. Said land does not appear to have been surveyed or appropriated to any other person (excepting a survey I made for Edward Clingin of which I presume you are legally notified)
