N.B. On the East end of the above survey there was once an im-
 provement made by one Ryerson and there was an order of resur-
 vey granted to William Mague ^{in Ret. of Dan^l Levy} on the 31st Jan. 1816 to exclude said
 improvement. The order was executed on the 27 Oct. 1817. the improve-
 ment has been abandoned upwards of 30 years. Doctor Rob^t
 Philips claims a part of 5^d survey by virtue of a warrant & survey
 to Daniel Levy dated 5th Dec^r 1793.
