



Situate in Loyalsock Township in the County of Lycoming resurvey'd the 7th day of May 1810 by Henry Donnel (a former Deputy) in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 20th day of September 1774 granted to Lewis Stout for two hundred and fifty acres of land but by reason of other claims interfering therewith after a long investigation no more than Thirty-two acres with allowance of Six pr. Cent. for Roads &c. appears to be Clear of other claims, and being earnestly requested by the present Claimant, as well as by the said Henry Donnel (who says the survey is correct) to sign a Return for the same Therefore forward it as it was handed to me by the said Henry Donnel with these remarks -
