



A Draft of a Tract of Land called Linleys Bottom situate on the waters of a small Creek which empties into the Susquehanna River a small distance above Exeter Narrows and about two miles from the River in Luzerne County containing one hundred and nine acres sixty-two perches and the allowance of six per centum for Roads Surveyed the fifth day of December one thousand eight hundred and one for Henry Schneider in pursuance of a warrant dated the twelfth day of May 1774.
