



Surveyed the 5th day of July 1824 in pursuance of a warrant granted Benjamin Morris bearing date the 26th day of December 1832 containing 12 acres and allowance of 6 per cent situate in Jefferson township in the County of Greene.

P.S. being doubtfull whether or no you have a return of this survey in your office I send this copy of the survey, and as the land on two sides has changed owners since the survey was made &c. I give the names of the present owners. I have sometimes waited long after making survey (where there is an excess over 10 per cent for the owners of the land to forward the money for the same) that it might be transmitted with the survey.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eighth day of January 1908
