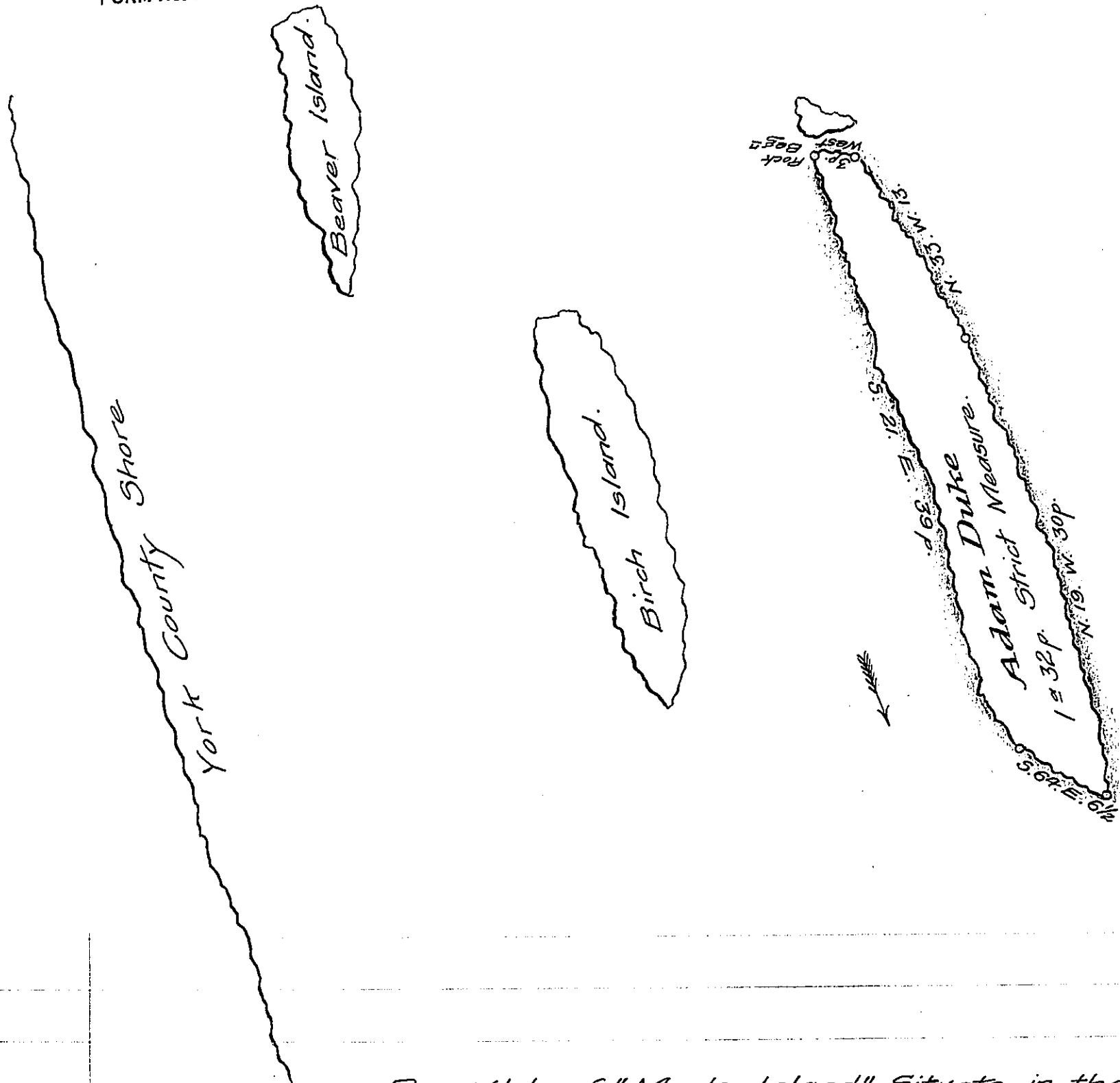

Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant, Dated the 29th Day of June A.D. 1820, granted to Adam Duke.*
