

Since the above was put into my hand by Mr Irish I have
 been induced to believe, that the tract of land above described was
 surveyed on the 14th day of June 1830, in pursuance of a warrant
 dated the 26th day of December 1829, granted to John L. Coko.

 Board of Property dated the 17th day of March 1830 it appears
 that the same has been returned to the Office of the Surveyor
 General.
