



A draught of an Island Situate in the river Susquehanna Martic Township Lancaster County opposite the place called the House rock, about one hundred yards above the upper point of Burkholders Island and about two hundred yards above Keagys rock. Containing three acres and one hundred and fifty nine perches Strict Measure Surveyed the 5th day of September 1815. In pursuance of a warrant dated the 4th day of January 1815. granted to Robert Cammeron & James Duncan.
