



A Draught of a Peice of Land situated in Antrim Township Franklin County Containing Twelve acres, and three fourth, & Allowance of Six p. Cent for Roads &c. Being part of a Tract of One hundred & ninety three acres & Allowance &c. which was Surveyed May 26th 1808 in Persuance of a Warrant, granted to John Wallace dated January 15th 1768. Surveyed and laid off from the other parts of the Tract October 5th 1808 by Thomas Fairby Esq^r (late Deputy Surveyor as appears by an official Draught there of remaining in this office.
