suance of a Warrant granted unto Martin Weimer dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day  
of December 1811.

N.B this Tract of Land John McClean Deputy  
is well Improved, and when Surveyed  
Martin Weimer with his family lived  
thereon and has continued so to do for  
many years past And from informa-  
tion together with the appearance of  
the Improvement, the Warrant has been  
Honestly obtained According to the spirit  
and meaning of the Law.
