It then Was Said to Contain 24 acres & 115 perches & Resurveyed the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December 1824. In pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property to me Directed Bearing date the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September 1824 And Now Contains fifty Acres and 166 perches & the usual Allowance.
