



The parts marked A & B are included in the surveys in the name of Isaac Connely that marked C in the survey of Charles Drum.

A Draught of a tract of land situate in Spring township Centre County containing three hundred and nineteen acres thirty four perches and the allowance of six P. Cent for roads & ca. resurveyed (agreeably to old lines which appear to have been run about the year 1775) for Michael Dowdle May 7th 1802 in pursuance of a Warrant dated July 19th 1773. The dotted lines with which survey interferes represent the surveys of Isaac Connely on w^{ts} dated July 5th 1784 & March 22^d 1788 and the survey of Charles Drum made on w^t dated July 20th 1784.
