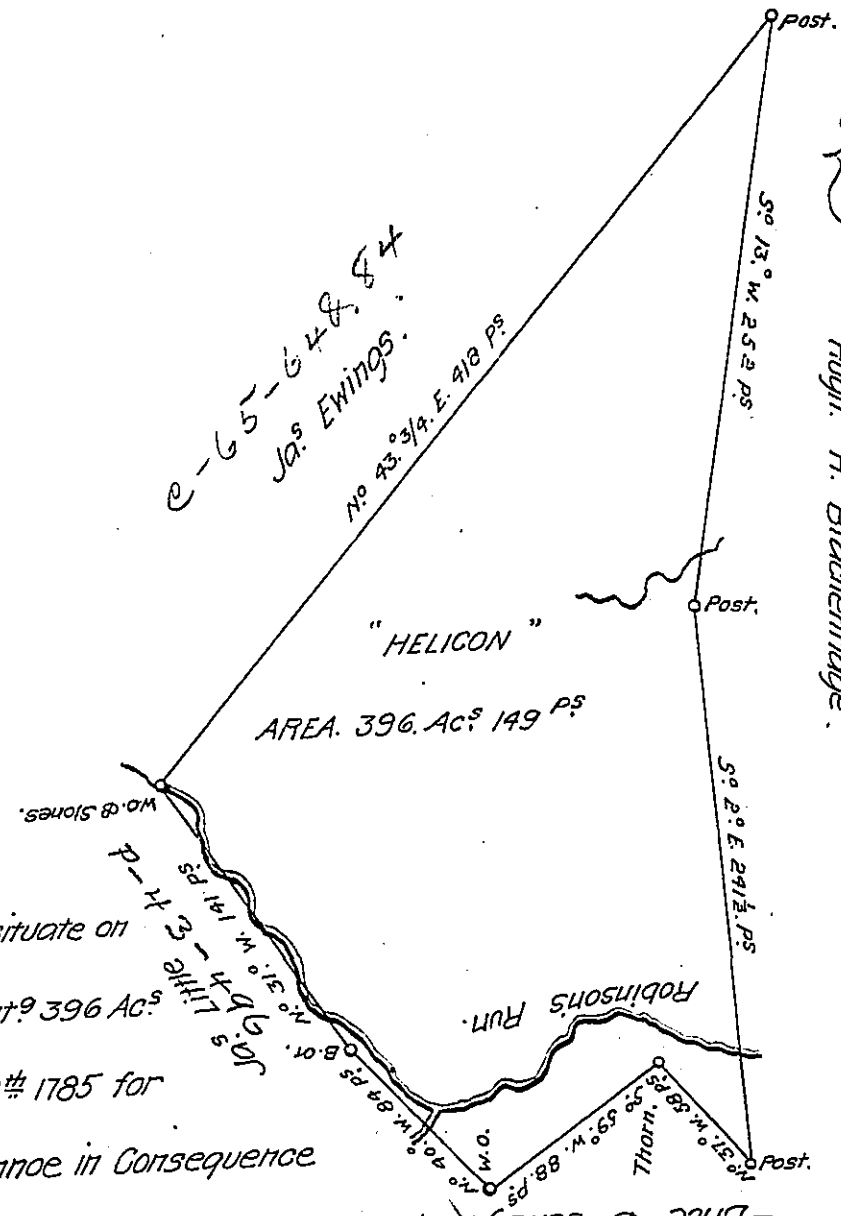

Brackenridge Ass<sup>es</sup> of W<sup>m</sup> Rennoe in Consequence of the following Certif<sup>s</sup> which does not appear on the authenticated List of Entries, but has the annexed Certif<sup>s</sup> signed by Col<sup>o</sup> Crawford (or some person for him) on ye back. Withe Commiss<sup>es</sup> for adjust<sup>g</sup> the Claims to unpatented Lands in ye Counties of Monong<sup>a</sup> yotg<sup>a</sup> and Ohio do hereby certify that W<sup>m</sup> Rennoe Ass<sup>es</sup> of Rich<sup>d</sup> Chamberlaine is entitled to 400 Ac<sup>s</sup> of Land in ye County of yotg<sup>a</sup> situate on Robinson's Run to include his Settlement made in ye year 1772. Given under our Hands at Cox's Fort ye 5<sup>th</sup> of Feb<sup>y</sup> 1780 and in ye 4<sup>th</sup> year of ye Commonwealth.
