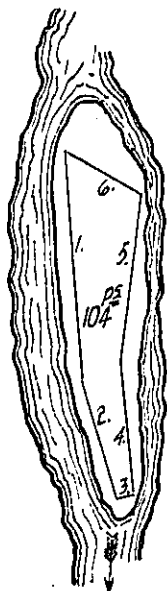

The above Island was surveyed on Warrant to John Fees, 15<sup>th</sup> Jan<sup>y</sup>, 1812 as appears by the Survey Book in my possession and lately been patented.

DRAFT of an Island situate in the Conewango Creek in Conewango Township, Warren County, about opposite the mouth of the Saw Mill Creek owned by Hebbord & Hatch on the East side of the Conewango Creek, the Island is nearest the East Side of the Creek and a short distance below one surveyed to John Hockmy, containing one hundred & four perches. Surveyed for John Hockmy on his Warrant granted to him dated 5<sup>th</sup> May A.D. 1828. July 3<sup>d</sup> 1828.
