Draft of an Island situate in Limestone now Deerfield Township, Warren County, in the Allegheny River and opposite the house of Andrew McGill and about half a mile above the Lower Line of Warren County. Containing eleven acres and one hundred and twenty one perches. Surveyed the 1st day of October, A. D. 1824, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James McGee of Limestone, Warren County. Dated March 29th 1824. Arthur McGill is in possession of above Island and forbids the Survey. Returned for confirmation.
