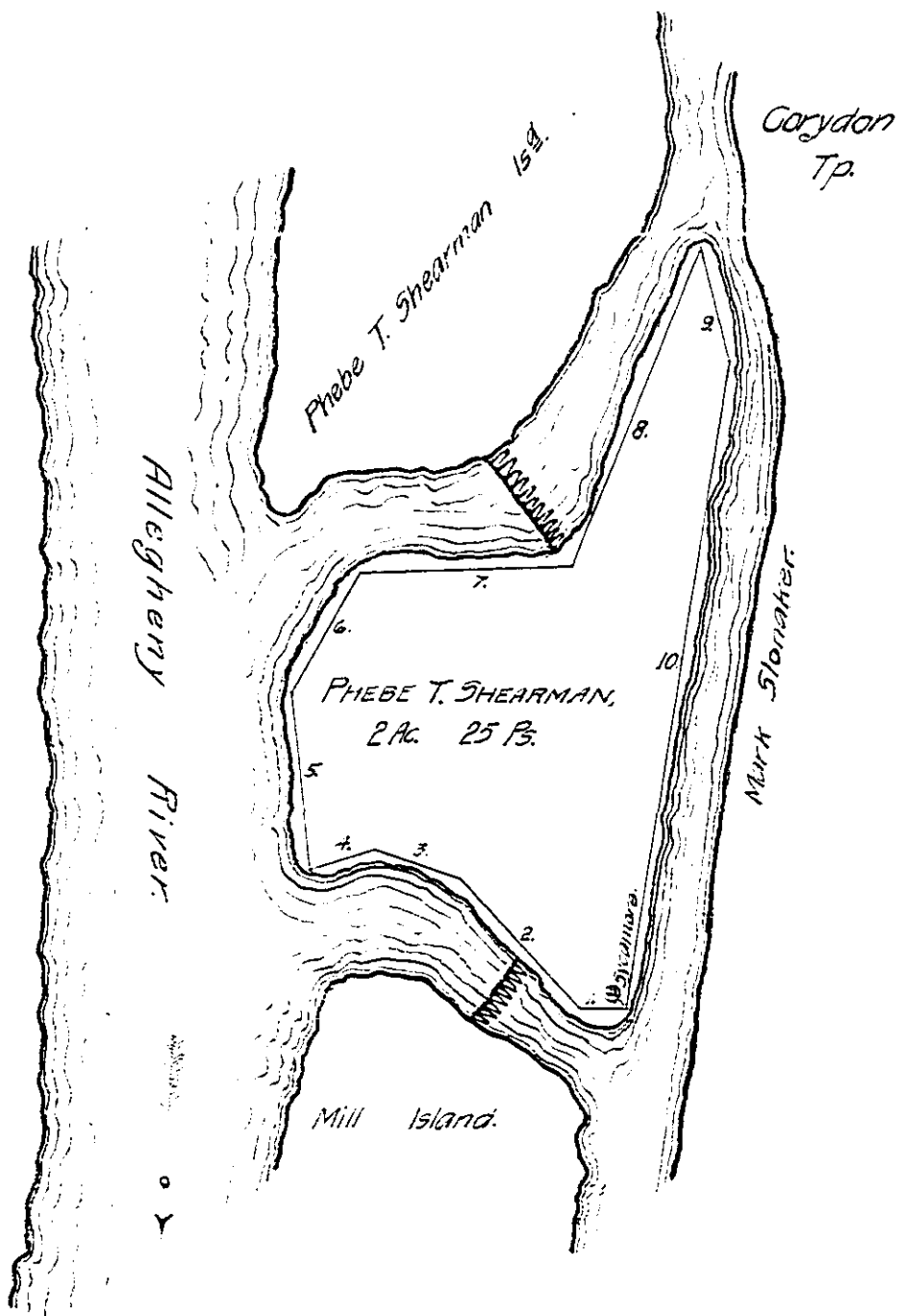

Surveyed for Phoebe T. Shearman, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to her dated the twentieth day of September, A.D. one thousand eight hundred & sixty one.

Witness my hand this 27th day of September, A.D. 1861.
