


**FORM NO 1.**



A draft of a tract of land containing three hundred and seventy-three acres and seventy-one perches and allowance of six per cent. for Roads &c. situate in Wayne Township, in the county of Mifflin; surveyed April 14th. & 15<sup>th</sup> 1869, in pursuance of a warrant granted to George B. Wharton, dated the 24th day of June 1868. Note. The 102 acres, 17 perches & allow. situate above the dotted line, is supposed to be an interference with the George Huse Tract. The red lines crossing the west end of the draft, show the line between Huntingdon & Mifflin Counties.
