There was survey'd for the said Samuel a part of the said quantity, vizt one hundred fifty seven acres with an allowance of Six per Cent and the said Tract is Situate in the County of Philadelphia near Rebbers Tract Beginning at a post at a corner of Hans George Riffs land Thence Running by the farm South West fifty four perches to a post Then North West by the land of Michael Zeigler ~~north west~~ one hundred and sixty perches to a black Oak Thence North East one hundred forty nine perches to a post Thence by Vacant land South East One hundred ninty One perches Then by John Shull's land South West ninety five perches to a post Then by Hans Riff's land North West thirty one perches to the place of Beginning
