



The Draught of a Tract of Land Allotted to Peter Hunt one of the sons of the late Roger Hunt of East Caln Township in Chester County Deceased Containing 63^{as.} beside the Allowance of Six $\frac{7}{8}$ Cent being a part of that Tract of 255 $\frac{1}{2}$ & Allowance of Land which was Surveyed for the Representatives of the said Roger by Two Warrants Granted to George Ashton the one Dated the 24th day of January 1736 the other the 17th day of January 1739.

This land in West Bradford Town^E. Sur^d 1st mo. 7th 1768 agreeable to a Dft. made by Dilworth in the possession of Joshua Way.
