



This Draught describes two small Pieces of Land in West Nottingham Township Chester County, which tho' survey'd se<sup>per</sup>ate were afterwards made one Tract by James Byers's Purchase, Laid out in Pursuance of two Warrants, the first granted to W. Kennedy the 20th. of October 1748 & the other to James Byers Dated the 20th. of February, 1753 --- Begining at a Corner chesnut in a Line of Joseph Collins Survey, & running thence according to the several Courses & distances above described; survey'd and certify'd By
