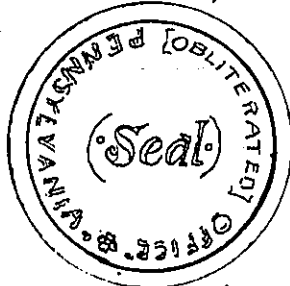


The Tract of Land above - described is situate <sup>part</sup> in Oxford (heretofore) & I believe part in West Fallowfield Township (Londonderry) Township, in the County of Chester, on a branch of Octoraro Creek called Muddy Run, surveyed for William Liggitt in pursuance of two warrants, viz: one granted to a certain Robert Kelly, bearing date the 1st. day of June 1748 (the right of which was purchased by said Liggitt) the other in his own name & dated the 27th. of October 1750, containing in the whole 140 acres & the allowance of Six per cent. Note A. 30 1/2 ac & allowance was purchased from Andrew McCartney but is not included in the return of his Survey, I therefore thought best to return the same upon the above mentioned warrants for said Liggitt, it being his purchase.
