

A Draft of a tract of land situated in the Townships of Brecknock and Counties of Berks and Lancaster, containing one hundred and eighty-three acres, eighty perches and allowance of six percent for roads, etc. Draughted for Adam Kern and others the seventh day of March 1901, it being part of a larger tract containing two hundred and thirty-three acres, ~~perches~~ and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Conrad Weiser dated the nineteenth day of August 1751.
