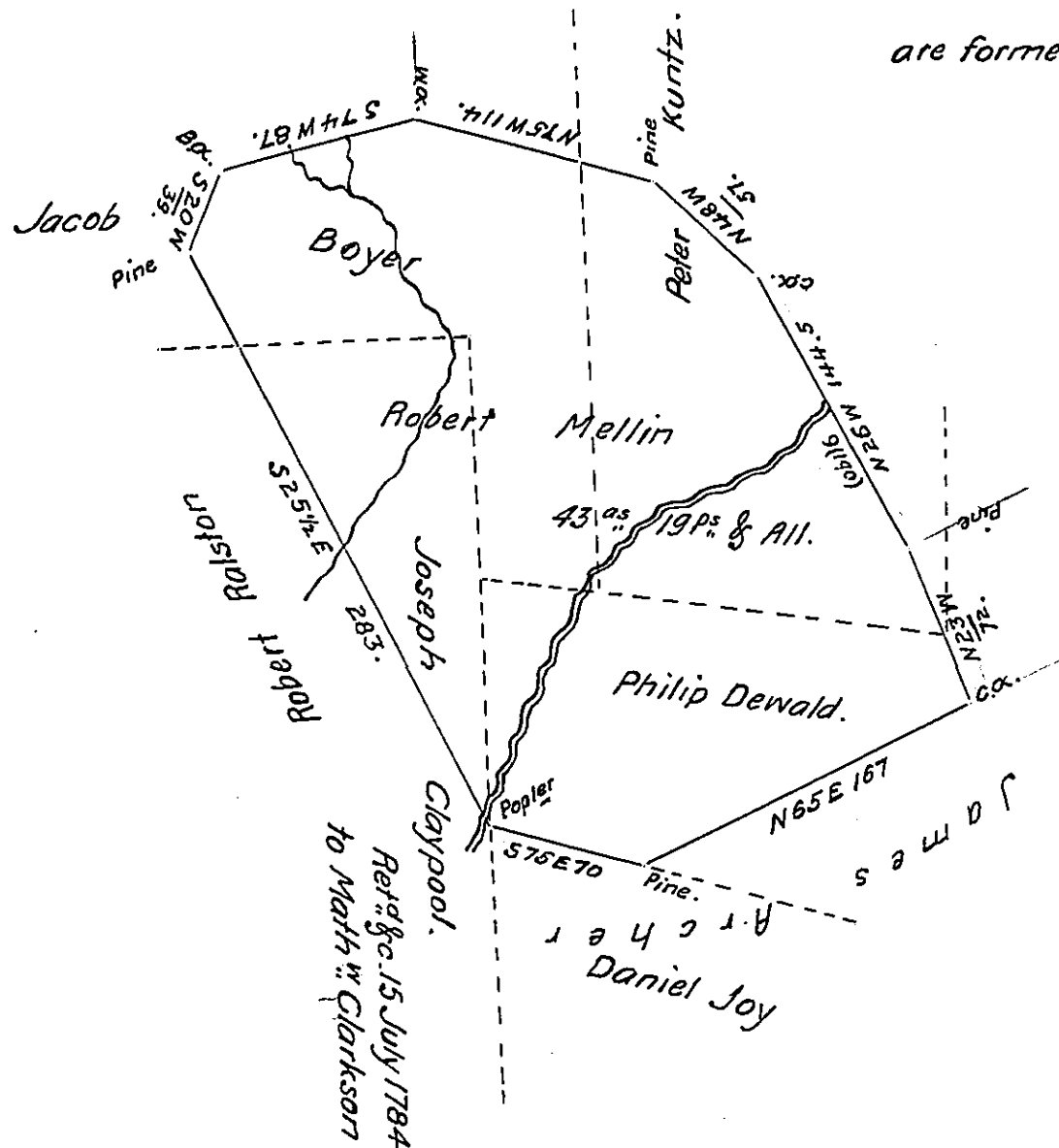

The improvements on the tract are a Square-log house with a family residing therein & about twenty Acres of cleared-land
