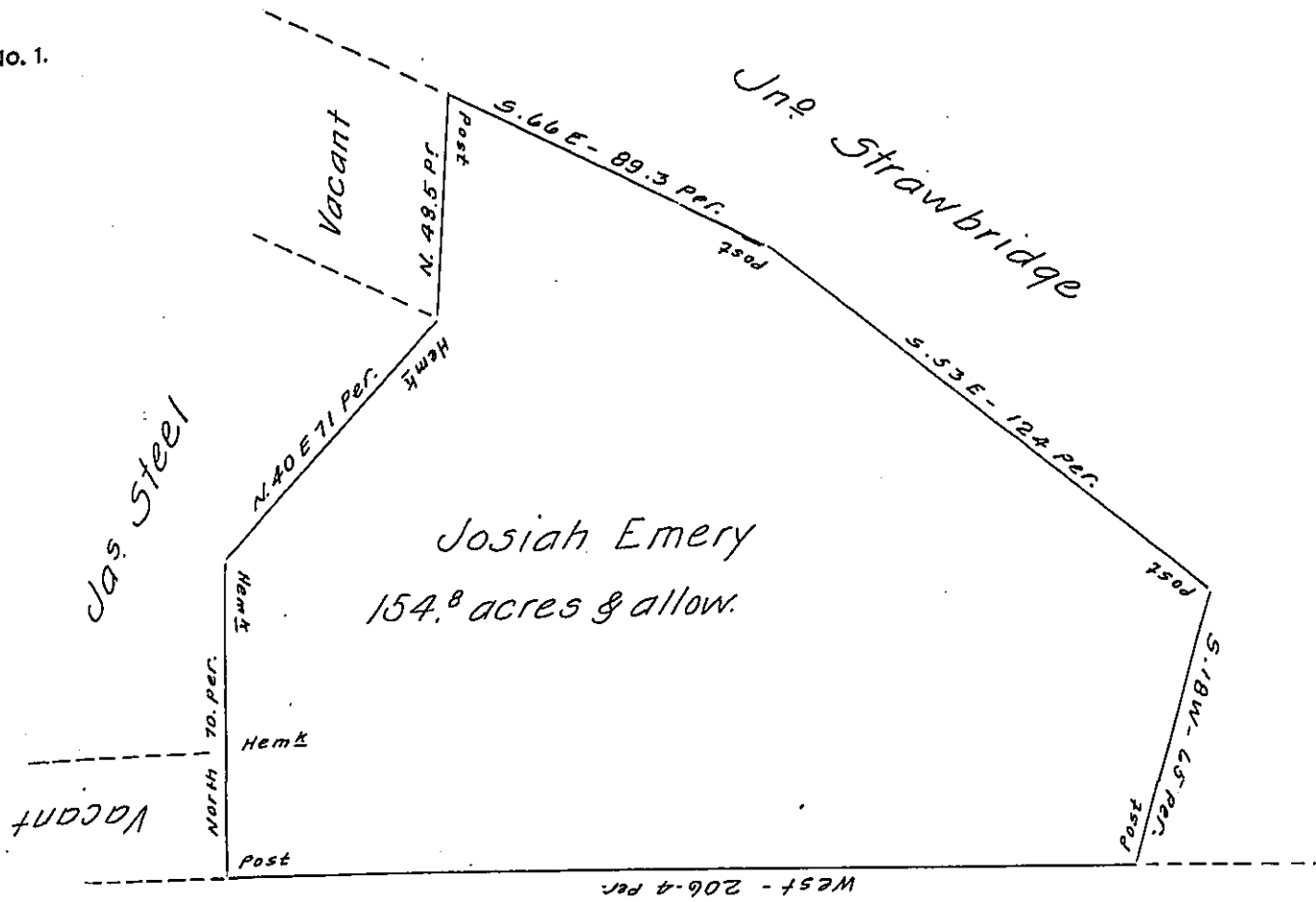

Survey of a Tract of Land made for Josiah Emery by Virtue of his Warrant granted to him by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for one hundred and fifty Acres of land and dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of Nov. A.D. 1836. Executed the fifth day of Aug<sup>r</sup> A.D. 1850. on land lying and being in Delmar Township, West of Big Marsh and Adjoining Land of James Wilson on the South, James Steel and Vacant Land on the West, and John Strawbridge on the North and East. Containing One hundred and fifty four acres and eight tenths of an acre. and Allowance of Six per Cent.
