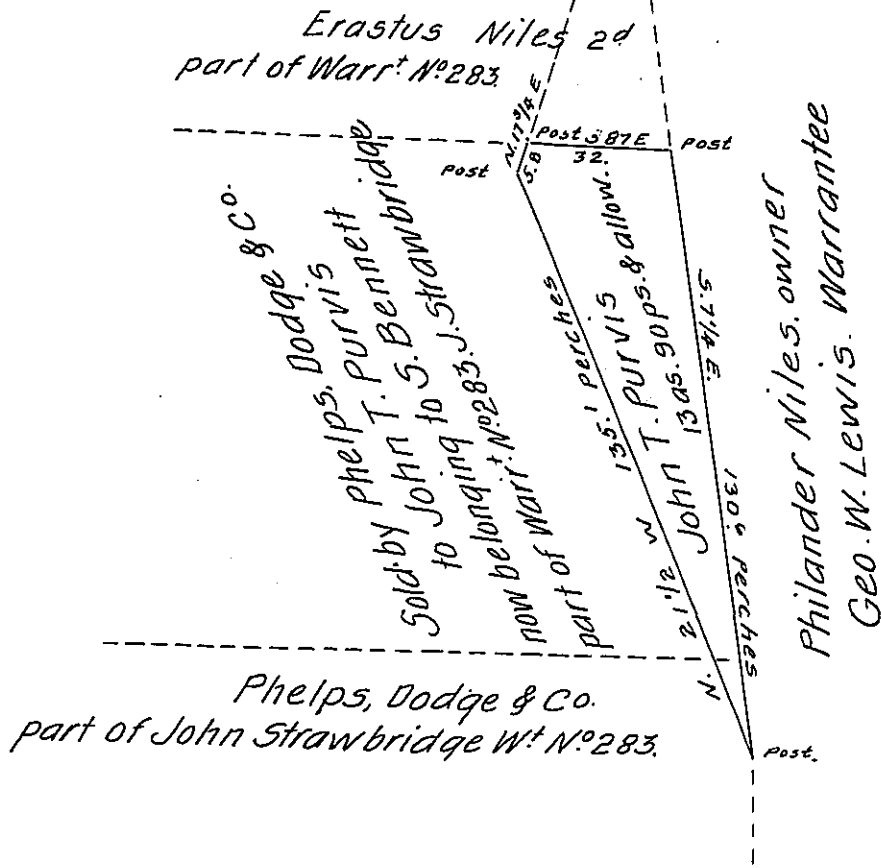


Hickory called for in Official return of N<sup>o</sup> 283.



The draft of a tract of unimproved land, situate in Middlebury township Tioga County, surveyed for John T. Purvis, in pursuance of a Warrant, dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of February 1857. Containing thirteen acres and ninety perches and the allowance of six per Cent. Surveyed on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of August 1865.

Note. The above described tract of land, with the exception of the small triangle south of the dotted line, was conveyed by Phelps, Dodge & Co. the then owners of that part of the Strawbridge Warrant N<sup>o</sup> 283, together with other lands lying West of it, as being a part of Warrant N<sup>o</sup> 283 to John T. Purvis, and (obl.) th (obl.) to Solomon Ben (obl.) t (obl.) Said Purvis, believing the above (obl.) scribed tract of land to be vacant, from the fact that the lines bounding it on the West, correspond in age with the Strawbridge Warrant N<sup>o</sup> 283, while those bounding it on the East, survey of the are of a more recent date. - To put his title beyond a doubt, he applied for and obtained the Warrant, in pursuance of which the above Survey has been made.
