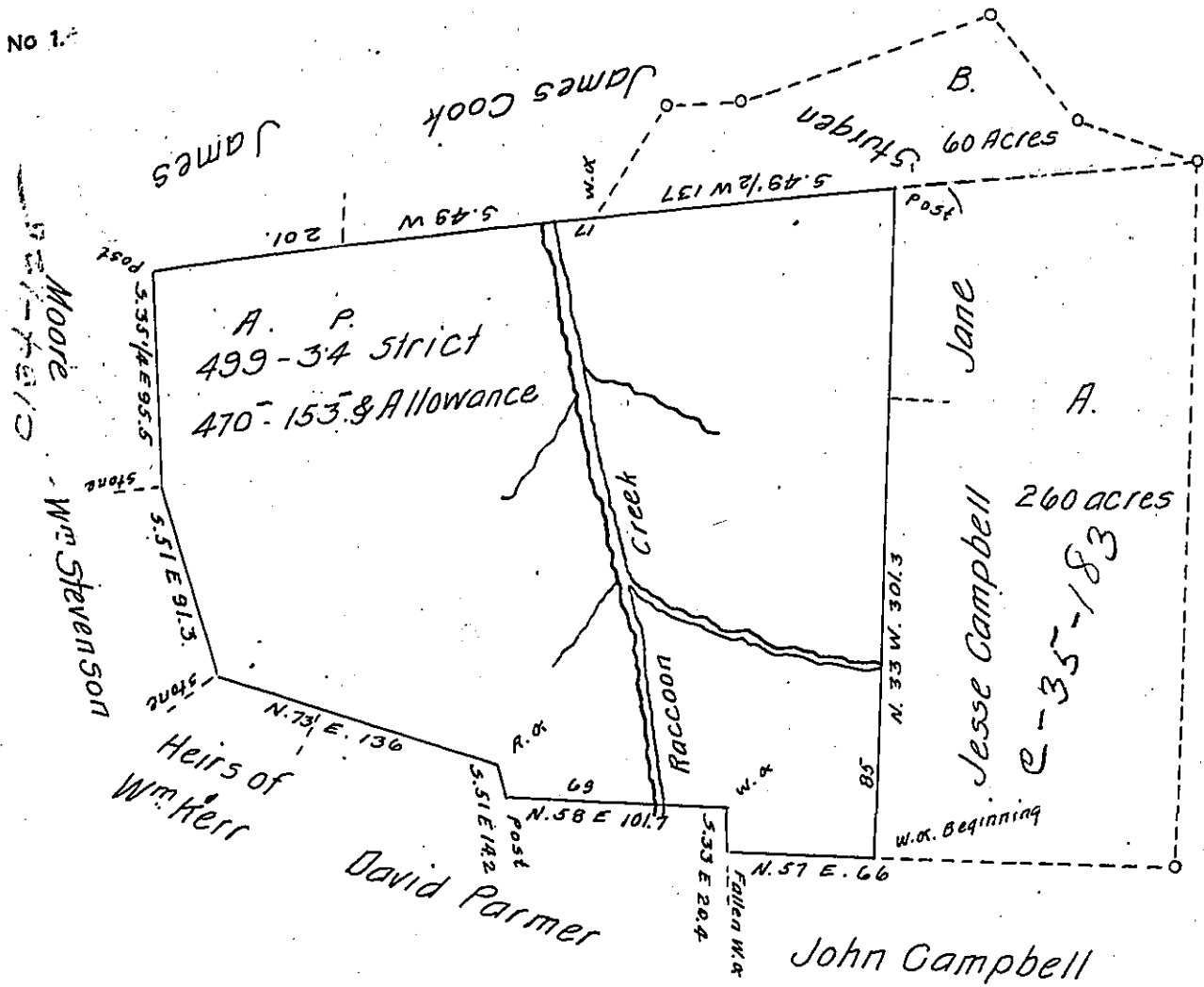


FORM NO 1.



The above is a Draught of a Survey made April 17<sup>th</sup> 1828. in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property granted to M. Stevenson, agent for W<sup>m</sup> and James Stevenson dated March 10<sup>th</sup> 1828. situate in Smith Township W.C. on the waters of Raccoon Creek. The outlines of the above Draught embraces the whole of two original Surveys made on two Virginia Certificates in the name of James Stevenson. the Compartment marked A. Contains 260 Acres and was recovered by W<sup>m</sup> Campbell for which he obtained a Patent. the Compartment marked B. Contains 60 Acres. and was recovered by - Rutherford. And the remainder enclosed by the black lines. Contains 499 Acres and 34 perches Strict measure, and is all that is not held by Older and better Titles.
