



The above is a Draught of a Survey made June 29<sup>th</sup> 1829. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Stephen Snyder. Dated June 19<sup>th</sup> 1829 for One Acre of land. but Contains Seven Acres. and one hundred and thirty one perches & Allowance of six pr. Cent for highways. Situate in Nottingham Township. W.C. on the waters Mingo Creek-  
 Note. at the time of Survey there was a house on the ground. but not occupied by any person. and also Grain growing in the fields. (said to belong to Conrad Oller.) the house appears to have been occupied once. but how long. or how long abandoned. I am unable to say.
