



Draft of a tract of land containing 83 Acres, 138 Perches & allowance of Six per cent for roads &c. Situate on Indian Creek in Springfield Township in the County of Fayette. Surveyed the 10th day of Nov. A.D. 1870. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Margaret Butler for 104 Acres of land dated the 26th day of March A.D. 1869.

There is part of this tract cleared and a Cabin erected on it. in which William Bakem & wife are now living. Bakem's wife is the daughter of Margaret Butler the Warrantee. M^{rs}. Butler is now deceased leaving three daughters. Bakem's wife objects to the issuing of the patent in the name of Margaret Butler, and claims the title to the land by possession.
