



In pursuance of a Law passed the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1799 for the Selling certain Reserved tracts of land therein named. the Instructions of Governor dated 14<sup>th</sup> May 1799. and the Order of the Surveyor General thereupon dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 1799. Surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> day of Sept. 1799 the above described tract of Land being Lot No. 11 of the Reserved tract called Warren in (now) Warren County. Containing Sixty Seven Acres and eighty perches strict measure.
