



In pursuance of a Law passed 11<sup>th</sup> April 1799 for the Selling of Certain reserved tract therein named the Instructions of the Governor Dated 14<sup>th</sup> May 1799 and the Order of the Surveyor General thereupon dated 18<sup>th</sup> May 1799 Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Sept. 1799 the above described tract of land being Lot No 13. of the reserved tract called Warren in (now) Warren County. Containing One hundred and six Acres & fifty perches strict measure.
