



In pursuance of a Law passed the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1799 for the selling certain reserved tracts therein named the Instructions of the late Governor dated 14<sup>th</sup> May 1799 and the order of the Surveyor General there upon dated 18<sup>th</sup> May 1799 Surveyed the 24 day of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1799 the above described tract of land being Lot No. 14 and Reserved for the use of schools in the Reserved tract called Warren in (now) Warren County Containing Five hundred and forty six Acres and Ninety one perches strict measure.
