



By Virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly of Penn^a on the thirtieth day of Jan^y. 1784 and Warrant dated the second day of february 1784 granting to Asell Burnham Three hundred acres of land. Surveyed July 26. 1841 to John H. Wallace the above described Tract of land situate on Burnt Bridge Brook in Milford Township (formerly Northampton County) now Pike Co. Containing Two hundred Ninety Seven acres and One hundred and forty five perches and the allowance of six pr Ct for Roads &c.
