Christian Kauble claims under an Improvement made about 15 years since. about 4 acres which has the appearance of being once cleared but is grown up wild not under fence. there was the appearance of a Cabin in Which Kauble had staid several nights he says but is towrn down. it appears to have been made of Round poles of about 15 feet long
