



By Virtue of a warrant dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 1787 and order of  
Survey rec'd the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1847 surveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May  
1847 to William Cox the above described tract of land situate in  
Lackawaxen Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County ad-  
joining land surveyed to Lewis Rue and including an improvement on  
Masthope Creek containing Two hundred and thirty two acres Ninety  
eight perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c
