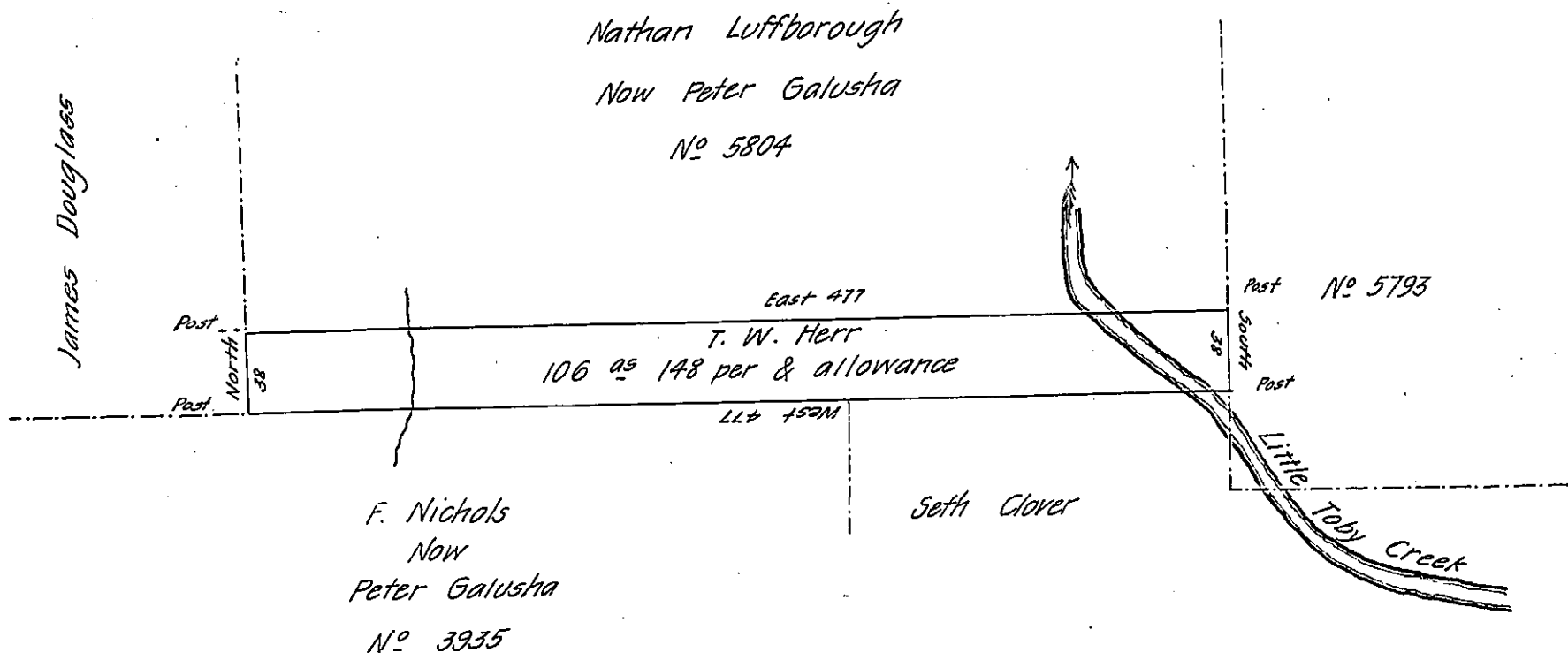


FORM NO 1.



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the fifteenth day of September 1865 and to  
 me directed, I have surveyed for Theodore W. Herr the above described tract of land,  
 containing one hundred and six acres and one hundred & forty eight perches and allow-  
 ance of six per cent for roads &c. Situate on the waters of Little Toby Creek in Snyder  
 Township Jefferson County Pennsylvania in the last purchase made of the Indians East of  
 the Allegheny River and Conewango Creek

September 27, 1865
