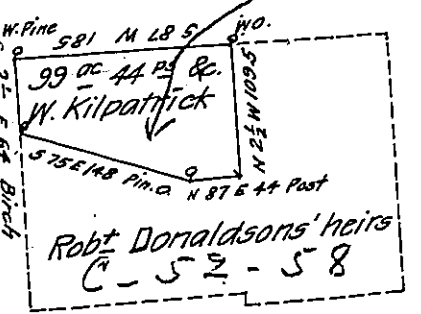

Surveyed May 5th 1842 for Wm Kilpatrick in pursuance of his actual settlement & improvement and also his right from the heirs of Robert Donaldson as by writing appears
