



Situate in Cheneford township in the County of York containing as above set forth 249 & 134 Acres and all appurtenances and all improvements thereon. Which was originally surveyed by William Mathews late D.S. on the 25th day of the 11th month 1774. In pursuance of a warrant for 259 granted to James Caldwell (bearing date the 22nd day of May Anno Domini 1772 and homologated on the 12th day of May Anno Domini 1813. resurveyed and a piece of vacant land added in pursuance of an order from the Honble. Board of property granted to Peter Mundorf bearing date the 9th day of March Anno Domini 1813. I further beg leave to state that Joseph & William Reed claims that part within the yellow lines by warrant of the 5th of June Anno Domini 1787 granted to their father Joseph Reed. To Richard T.
