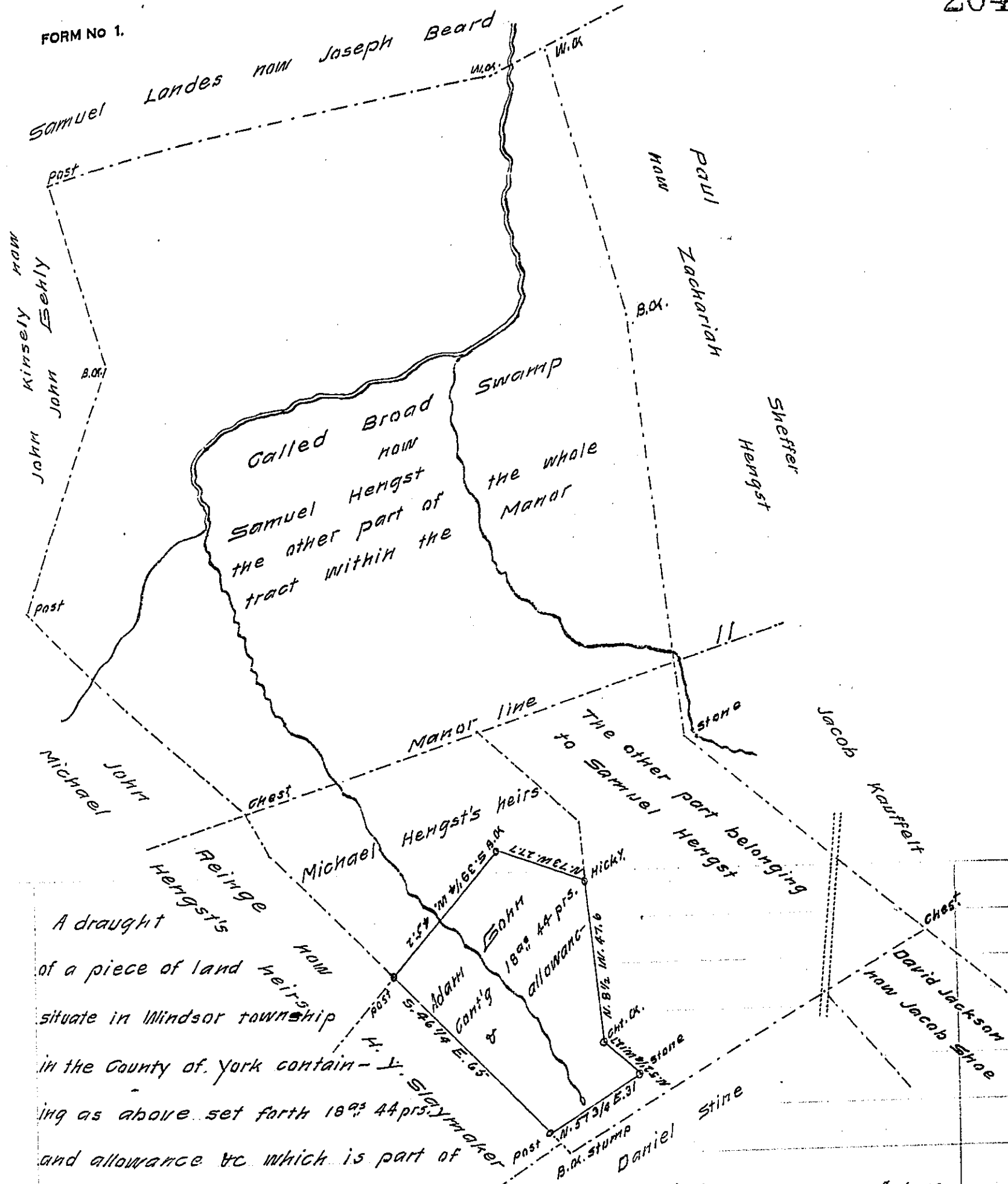


FORM NO 1.



A draught of a piece of land situate in Windsor township in the County of York containing as above set forth 189 44 prs. and allowance &c which is part of 25 1/4 ac & allowances which was originally surveyed in pursuance of two warrants. One for 50 ac dated 1st June 1762 the other for 100 ac dated the 5th day of July 1762 granted to Adam Sohm, and surveyed by Wm Mathews D.S. on the 13th day of 6th mo. 1766 &c. Now resurveyed and divided said larger tract &c. and now on the 20th day of June A.D. 1836 being requested to make return of the above for Henry Slaymaker the present owner &c.
