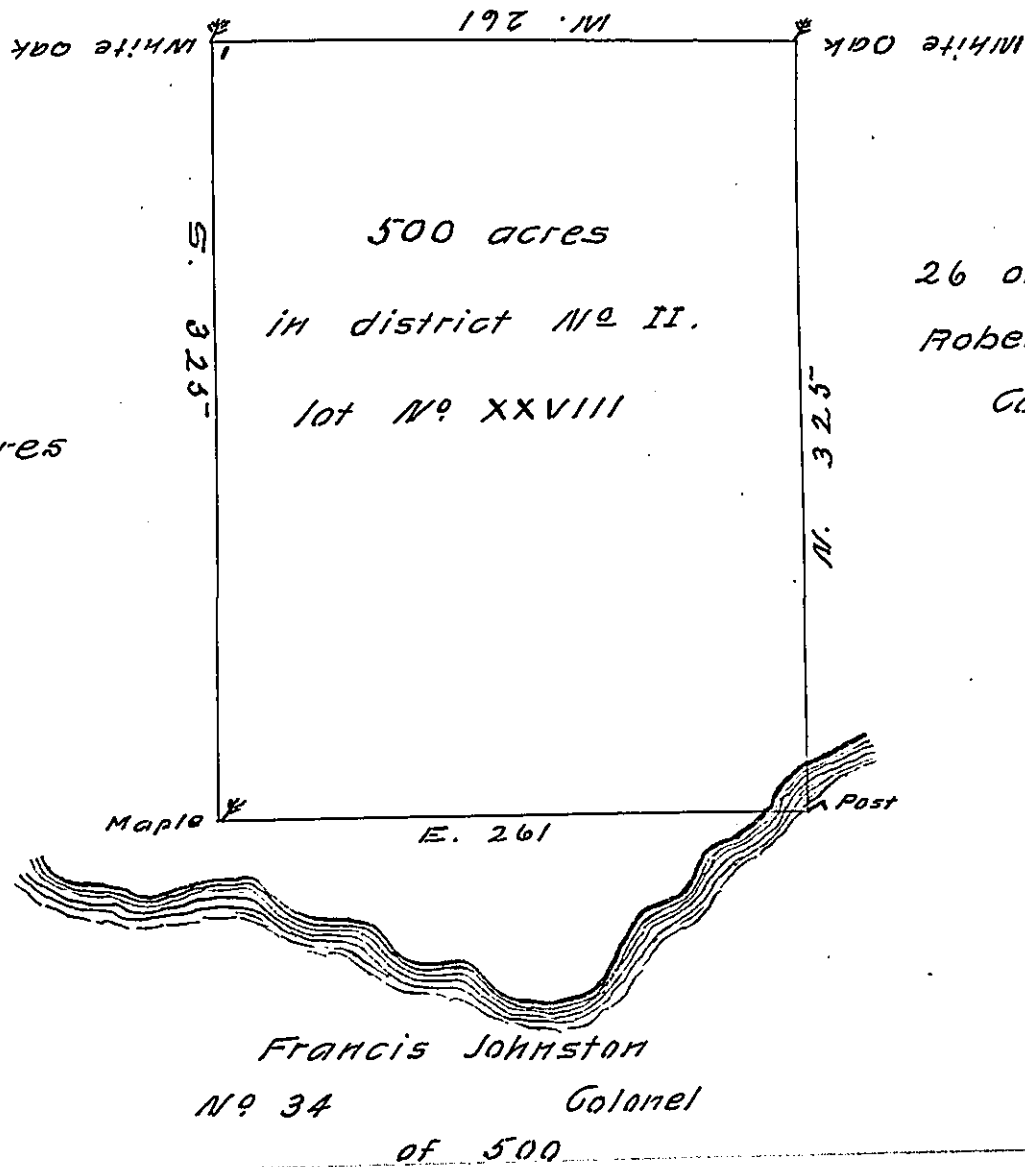

ance of six per cent for roads &c and marked in the
general plan of donation lands No XXVIII.
